Geography Skills and Knowledge

Expected by the end of year 3

Geographical Skills

- interpret and explain key information on rivers
- evaluate a range of possible flood prevention measures
- Identify the position and significance of lines of latitude, including the Equator and the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn
- use appropriate vocabulary when describing the rainforest and other biomes; river features and place locations.
- use appropriate vocabulary when describing key information about the UK to external audiences.

Mapping Skills

- use globes, atlases and maps to locate the world's principal rivers
- use globes and atlases to identify the location and distribution of rainforest and other biomes
- interpret a range of maps of the UK and the local region and apply this information to their understanding of it
- use maps and supporting information to route-plan a tourist trip around the capital cities of the UK

In addition, children should have had the opportunity to further develop their skills of enquiry and fieldwork (including the use of data and mapwork), and to make regular use of globes and atlases, through incidental opportunities within other subjects, via 'geography in the news' and through dedicated fieldwork days.
