Geographical Skills

- Locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on North America, concentrating on its environmental regions and key physical and human characteristics. (Autumn/Summer)
- Identify the position and significance of latitude and longitude. (Autumn)
- Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography, including: mountains (Spring)
- Describe the climate of the mountains and explore mountain life. (Spring)
- Understand time zones and work out time differences. (Autumn)
- describe and understand key aspects of human geography, including economic activity and trade links, the distribution of natural resources including food (Autumn)
- Use appropriate vocabulary when describing global trade and supply chains (Autumn)

Mapping Skills

- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied. (All)
- Name and locate key topographical features of the UK (including mountains). (Spring)
